| 授業の 目的と概要 | This class is designed to teach the basics of linguistic research methodology from a scientific standpoint. It will cover how to obtain a proper framework for research, various types of tests used in linguistics and how to perform them, data analysis, including but not limited to basic statistical analysis, ethical considerations and how to put it together into a report. |
| 学習の 到達目標 | Upon completing this course, students will be able to: (1) apply linguistic research methods to a framework (2) understand and/or perform linguistic tests and experiments (3) complete simple data analysis (4) write a basic research report |
