- (★)** Please refrain from business trips and travel to areas where the infection has spread (the Tokyo metropolitan area (Tokyo, Saitama, Kanagawa, and Chiba prefectures), Osaka, Kyoto, Hyogo, Aichi, Fukuoka, and Okinawa prefectures).
If you receive a guest from areas where we have asked you to refrain from visiting, we ask you to exercise caution, but please take thorough measures to prevent infection, such as taking guests' temperature and managing guests' health.
- (★★)** If you are returning home, you should take care to check the status of the infection in the area you are returning to. If you return to your home country for unavoidable reasons, please be aware of the risk of infection among elderly people and refrain from eating and drinking in groups.

- * These restrictions do not apply to coronavirus-related medical staff and researchers.
- * TU BCP may be revised at any time due to changes in the phase of infection, situation etc.
- * In the event of an overseas business trip, you will be notified separately, depending on the infection situation at the destination.
