Procedure for Submitting the “Master’s Thesis Provisional Title Registration” Form

M2 students expected to complete the degree program in March 2022 must submit your “Master’s Thesis Provisional Title Registration” Form (*shūshi ronbun kari daimoku todoke* 修士論文仮題目届) and presentation material (*resume* レジюме) to the Academic Affairs Office, as per the following procedures. 1. How to submit the “Master’s Thesis Provisional Title Registration Form”

Enter your provisional title in the Excel format and send it to the Academic Affairs Office by the deadline via the following link: <https://forms.gle/6rWyRAvfoJ7s3kJ57>

No personal seal is required when you submit it.

- ※ Please be sure to consult with your academic advisor about your research topic by e-mail, etc. before you decide on your provisional title.
- ※ If the title is in English, please follow "Notation format of the research title and the thesis title".
- ※ If you write your name in English, please follow "How to write your name on the document in English".

2. “Master’s Thesis Provisional Title Registration Form” Deadline

Submission Deadline: June 30 (Wed.), 2021, by 17:15 ※Strictly observed

3. Presentation Material Deadline

Submission Deadline: July 7(Wed.), 2021, by 17:15 ※Strictly observed

Submit your material in MS-Word, 2 pages (A4 size paper) to the Academic Affairs Office via the following link: <https://forms.gle/GoZDuHx6f7m31Krx7>

- ※ Please add the designated password to your file before submission. The password will be sent to your DC mail.

Please refer to the student handbook (*gakusei binran* 学生便覧 Page.160 for those who entered in the graduate school in AY2020) for the style of the presentation material .

The presentation order will be announced on the GSICS English website after July 14(Wed.).

4. Important Notes

Please prepare your presentation material for Master’s thesis plan presentation on July 28 (Wed.) or July 29 (Thu.) with the same title you registered it with.

- ※ In the past, some students have entered an incorrect provisional title with their presentation materials. However, it is the rule that no materials will be accepted after the times and dates indicated above.
