Hannah Meadley-Roberts joined the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD) in April 2013 as Director of the President's Office. The principal responsibilities of in that role were to advise the President on key issues relating to the work of the EBRD and the day-to-day management of the organisation.

During 2016 Hannah took up the position of Acting Managing Director, Operational Effectiveness & Efficiency (OE&E) focussing on process improvements, system and people development. The OE&E function merged with HR in early 2018 and Hannah then assumed the new role of Managing Director, Human Resources and Organisational Development.

Prior to joining the EBRD, from 2010 to 2013 Hannah held various posts with the British Government, including Deputy Director Strategic Planning, Performance, Governance and Secretary to the Ministry of Justice (MoJ) Board concentrating on long term strategy for the Ministry and legislative and operational improvement. Between 2008 and 2010 Hannah was Private Secretary to the Permanent Secretary assisting in dealing with key issues affecting the MoJ as well as sensitive political negotiations, organisational development and stakeholder handling.
