The Historical Significance & Future Challenges of International Competitive Funding for Education

This seminar will provide an overview of the results of competitive funding programs such as the Strategic Fund for Establishing International Headquarters in Universities, G-30, GGJ, SGU, and the Inter-University Exchange Project, and will focus on recent trends in competitive funding. We will consider the implications for each stakeholder - universities, international students, domestic students and society (employers). Competitive funding has been praised for its role in promoting the internationalization of universities, however on the other hand, it has also been criticised for the disparities it has created between universities. We will discuss the merits and demerits of public funding and identify issues for the future.
