HYI FELLOWSHIP

HYI's multi-year full fellowship covers the two-year master's degree in Harvard's RSEA program.

HYI FELLOWSHIP ELIGIBILITY

- To be eligible for the HYI fellowship, you must be a citizen of an Asian country
- Students should be committed to pursuing a Ph.D. as preparation for an academic career and planning to return to Asia to teach upon completion of their graduate studies.
- Applicants who hold degrees (or are currently enrolled in degree programs) from English-medium universities outside of Asia are ineligible for the HYI fellowship.
